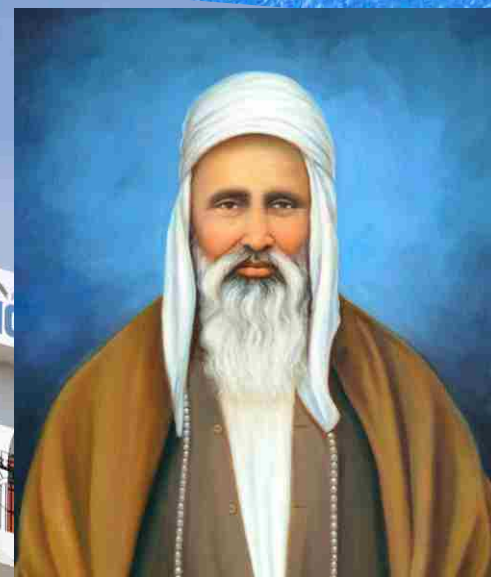

Sant Baba Harbans Singh ji (Kutiya Sahib Wale) laid the foundation stone of this college on 24 April 1966 and handed over its service to S. Joginder Singh Grewal (P.P. Sahib) For many years. S. Joginder Singh Grewal offered his services to people of rural areas through Patna Sahib Education Trust. The sole Objective of Patna Sahib Trust was Physical, mental and moral development of rural residents. Since 51 years the College has been imparting education to rural areas.

There was time when college was caught in a huge financial trap but due to Baba ji's inspiration and need of hour, I had been continuing my services since March 2003.

Earlier girl students had to go far off cities for higher education but now they have opportunity to seek knowledge while staying with their families. Bus service has been arranged especially for encouraging girl's enrollment in college and it will continue to remain in later years.

I always wanted betterment of area. I wish that students after seeking knowledge from this college must serve prestigious departments. Present day is an era of electronic media. Information Technology has made world- a global Village, Earlier, I managed to arrange computers in various schools of this area to make students capable of competing with their fastly moving counterparts in world.

Moving ahead on the path of progress, we started up PGDCA, BCA and computer (as an Elective Subject) in Govind National College. Our managing committee has been successful in shaping one of the highly cherished dreams of S. Joginder Singh Grewal to generate Sports and Physical Education teachers. All the Students who earlier had to visit far off Places like Nagpur, Amravati, Patna Sahib etc, for higher education in sports need not to go anywhere as B.P.Ed. (2 Years Duration Course After BA), M.P.Ed. and D.P.Ed. have been Started in our college since academic sessions of 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2009-10 respectively. After Attaining degree, such Students can join schools as DP/PT or lecturer in colleges. From 2017-18 we have introduce B.Sc. (Agriculture) four years course, Sociology as elective subject at U.G. level & one more M.P. Ed. unit.

B. Com, Msc. Maths and MA Punjabi Courses are also offered by the college. Apart from this, Add-on courses like yoga & Mental Health, Spoken English, IT, are also recognized under UGC.

Bus service for girls and modernized hostel facilities for boys and girls are provided by the College. New College canteen has been set up to ensure proper food for hostellers.

My managing committee is working hard day and night for good will of the college. It's an appeal to the very residents of this area to help us in increasing strength of college (through admission of Students) the more you inspire me (by getting enrolled in the College) the more I will work for its betterment.

New indoor sports Auditorium and shooting Range have been set up with the aid of UGC. It gives me an immense joy in informing that earlier, the shooting range facility was just in Dasmesh Girls College of Education, Badal, P.U., Chd. and Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, P.U. Chandigarh and now this facility is also available in our college- Govind National college, Narangwal.

Considering the problem of shortage of rooms, we managed to build Post Graduate Block in memory of Baba Harbans singh ji and Baba Gurditt Singh Girls hostel was set up with aid of UGC.

The managing Committee of this College Purchased 2 buses and Tata Magic to facilitate bus service. 125KW Gen set has been arranged to overcome difficulty of Power Shortage. Whole Campus has been equipped with inverter, Water Coolers and LCD TV's to create homely environment internet facility has been provided to staff and students to match up to marching ahead counterparts in the world. Housing facility has been arranged for fourth class employees at free of cost. Our college is taking lead in providing such Services.

## GOVIND NATIONAL COLLEGE on the Path of Continuous Progress...

The founder president of our college, S. Joginder Singh Grewal (P.P. Sahib) established several trusts. In the year 1952, he established Nankana Sahib Educational Trust. Guru Nanak Engineering College, Gill Park, Ludhiana was the creation of Nankana Sahib Educational Trust. In those days, 75% seats were reserved for rural students. On the same lines, S. Joginder Singh Grewal founded Patna Sahib Educational trust on 13 August, 1962. The foundation stone of Govind National College was laid on 24 April, 1966 by Sant Baba Harbans Singh Ji, the day which also marked the 300 years of the memory of Sri Guru Gobind Singh Ji.

Since the college campus touched the boundaries of adjoining six villages, it was decided that the name of the college will not be associated with the name of any particular village. So the college was named 'Govind Nagar'. The college received affiliation from Panjab University in the Syndicate proceeding (No.127) dated 23-04-1966. The college thus began offering courses in Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Science.

The college has faced many challenges in the past. There had also been a time when this esteemed institution had been on the verge of closing down. But with the blessings of Kutiya Sahib and the sustained efforts of S. Jagpal Singh Khangura, the college again started moving in the positive direction of development.

Dear Students,

S. Joginder Singh Grewal had dreamt some dreams and just like him, I also had certain dreams for this esteemed institution. To fulfill these dreams, I have been putting in sustained efforts since March 4, 2005.

When I took charge as the Principal, the college was offering courses only in Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Science with the blessings of 'Kutiya Sahib', I contributed to the academic and infrastructural growth of the college.

In the year 2006, we started offering courses like P.G.D.C.A., B.P.Ed, M.Sc. (Maths) and M.A. (Punjabi). In the year 2007, we started B.C.A. and M.P.Ed and in the year 2009 D.P.Ed. We also started the Research Centre for pre Ph.D. coursework in 2012. In the year 2015, we started offering B.Com at the undergraduate level and 2017 saw the beginning of B.Sc. (Agriculture) in our institution. In this way, we started providing more educational options and facilities to the residents of surrounding areas.

On the infrastructural front, when I had taken charge as the Principal, we did not even have a proper boundary wall around the campus. The first thing I did was demarcation of our land and getting it released from trespassers and build a proper boundary wall around the campus. Proper windows and doors were put up in Guru Nanak Bhawan as we needed more classrooms for new courses. This college did not even have a canteen so we built one in the year 2009. I also put in sustained efforts and a got a grant of Rs. 60 lakh from U.G.C. and built Baba Gurdit Singh Girls hostel. The grant from M.P. Munish Tiwari went into building a water tank and residential quarters for fourth class employees. U.G.C. grant in the year 2011-12 went into building a state of the Art Indoor Shooting Range and Indoor Sports Stadium. Later in the year 2013-14, new academic block, seminar hall, staff room, principal's office and office building were built. In the academic session 2016-17, Baba Gurdit Singh memorial block was also built atop the old building.

We also have multimedia lab, language lab, computer lab and physiotherapy labs in the college. The physiotherapy lab provides free treatment to the local residents. Our hostel has facilities like filtered water, geysers and invertors. Our library is a treasure house of books and we also have computer and digital corners.

We have 400 metre racing track, football ground, hockey ground, handball ground, volley ball ground, Kho-Kho ground, Gymnasium, Indoor Shooting range, Basketball and Kabaddi grounds in the college.

The NAAC team accredited the college with a B<sup>++</sup> grade and a score of 2.79. This year we gave approximately 5 lakh rupees to the meritorious students of the college.

We hosted Panjab University Zonal Youth Festival four times in the years 2005, 2007, 2010 and 2015 respectively. Since the year 2005, convocation has been held in the college five times. Eminent personalities like Kumari Agatha K Sangma, Rajinder Kaur Bhathal, V. C. Shivinder Singh Gill, Ravneet Singh Bittu and Dr. Tejinder Kaur (Chairperson P.S.E.B.) distributed degrees to the students. This year we were honoured by the esteemed presence of Vice Chancellor Prof. Arun Kumar Grover on the convocation day. This year we also organized Kissan Mela in the college campus.

The college has seen a spurt in the number of students which has gone up from 300 to 850.

S. Joginder Singh Grewal (P.P. Sahib) had wished that the students of the college should also be well employed after completing their studies. We are happy to announce that our students from M.P.Ed., B.P.Ed., D.P.Ed. and M.Sc. (Maths) are all well placed. The students of B.Sc. My dream was that the name of our college should be well known and with the blessings of 'Kutiya Sahib Wale Baba Ji', the dream has come true.

#### Admission to B.A./B.Sc.(1st Semester):-

4.1 a) A person who has passed one of the following examinations with pass in English as one of the subjects shall be eligible to join the 1st Sem. class of B.A./B.Sc. in a college affiliated to P.U. Chd. however, a person who has not qualified English as one of the subject at the +2 examinations, shall be eligible to join B.A./B.Sc.-1st Sem. provisionally subject to his/her qualifying the deficient subject of English from the parent Board/Body/Council/ University in two consecutive chances subsequent to his admission, failing which his/her admission to B.A./B.Sc. 1st Sem. class and the result for the examination shall automatically stand cancelled.

- (i) the +2 examination under 10+2+3 system of education of a recognized University / Board/ Council.
- (ii) any other examination recognized by the University as equivalent to (i) above.

Provided that;

- (i) a person joining the B.Sc. course must have obtained at least 40 percent marks in the aggregate of the qualifying examination;
- (ii) a person joining B.Sc. course must have passed at least 2 Science subjects in the qualifying examination out of the three elective subjects offered by him, except Anthropology. He may offer the third elective subject from the Faculty of Science or Faculty of Arts, subject to the restrictions as laid down in the Regulation 2.2.

Provided further that a student shall be eligible to opt the subject of-

- (i) Computer Science at the B.A. /B.Sc. level if he/she has passed the +2 examination with Science / Commerce / Economics / Mathematics and computer related subjects like Computer Information Tech as elective or optional Subjects as his subject/s.
- (ii) A student may opt for Computer Science in B.Sc. (General) Non-Medical) as one of the elective subjects with the following combination (amended vide Syndicate Paragraph 32, dated 11.7.2005):-  
(a) Mathematics (b) Physics (c) Computer Science

(b) A candidate who has been placed Under compartment in the +2 examination conducted by a Board/Body/Council/University in India shall be eligible to seek admission to the First Year of B.A./B.Sc. course, provided he fulfils the following conditions:-

He should have been placed in compartment in one subject only;

He should have obtained at least 20% marks in the subject in which he had been placed in compartment and He should have obtained the requisite percentage of marks in the aggregate of the examination as laid down in the relevant regulations.

Provided that:-

A candidate joining the B.A., First Year class should have obtained at least 33% marks in the



aggregate of all the subject (including the marks obtained by him in the subject of compartment, Theory & Practical/s taken together) taken up by him at the +2 examination.

A candidate joining the B.Sc., First Year class should have obtained at least 40% marks in the aggregate of all the subject (including the marks obtained by him in the subject of compartment, Theory & Practical/s taken together) taken up by him at the +2 examination.

4.2 A candidate who has been placed under compartment at +2 examination conducted by a Board/Body/Council/University in India shall be eligible to seek admission to the First Semester of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com/B.C.A./course/s he/she fulfills the following conditions:-

- (i) He/she should have been placed in compartment in one subject only;
- (ii) He/she should have obtained at least 20% marks in the subjects in which he/she had been placed in compartment and;
- (iii) He/she should have obtained the requisite percentage of marks in the aggregate of examination as laid down in the relevant regulations;

Provided that;

- (i) A candidate joining the B.A. First Semester should have obtained at least 33 % marks in the aggregate of all the subjects (including the marks obtained by him/her in the subject of compartment, Theory & Practical/s taken together) taken up by him/her at the +2 examination.
- (ii) A candidate joining the B.Sc. First Semester should have obtained at least 40% marks in the aggregate of all the subjects (including the marks obtained by him/her in the subject of compartment, Theory & Practical/s taken together) taken up by him/her at the +2 examination.

Admission to Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA) 1st Year

- (a) A person who has passed the +2 examination in any discipline with at least 50% marks and passed mathematics as one of the subject at Matriculation level shall be eligible to join the first semester class of B.C.A. Course.

or

- (b) Any other examination recognized by the Syndicate as equivalent to (a) above.

**Note:-** (i) 10% weight-age be given for each subject of (Mathematics/Statistics) and (Computer Science/Computer Applications/Information Technology or equivalent) to the candidate who studied at 10+2 level at the time of admission in B.C.A. 1<sup>st</sup> Semester from the admissions of 2015.

(ii) That 20% weight-age in total to those students who studied (Mathematics/Statistics) and (Computer Science or Computer Applications or Information Technology or Information System) at +2 level be given.

#### ADMISSION TO BACHELOR OF COMMERCE (B.Com.) 1<sup>ST</sup> SEMESTER :-

3.1 (A) Admission to the first semester of B.Com. Degree course shall be open to a person who has passed one of the following examinations conducted by a recognized Board/Council/University :-

- a) +2 examination of B.Com. Part-I (Old scheme) of Panjab University with three of the following subjects securing **at least 45 per cent** marks in the aggregate :-

Commerce (or theory of commerce or foundation course in commerce)

Accountancy (or book keeping and accountancy)

Economics

Business Organization (or Business Management or Theory and Practice of Management), Insurance (or General Insurance or Life Insurance)

Banking and Trade

Commercial Geography

Office Management and Secretarial Practice (or Office Organization and Management)

Mercantile Law (or any Company Law)

Auditing

Typewriting and Stenography / Computers (for typewriting)

- b) +2 Examination or B.A. Part-I (Old Scheme) of Panjab University with at least two of the subjects



mentioned in (a) securing at least 50% marks in aggregate;  
 c) +2 Examination or B.A. Part-I/B.Sc. I/Pre-Engineering/Pre-Medical Examination of the Panjab University under the Old Scheme not covered in (b) securing at least 50% marks.  
 d) Any other examination recognized by the University as equivalent to (a) or (b) or (c) as given above with requisite percentage of marks under each clause.

Provided that a candidate seeking admission to the first semester of B.Com should have passed in the subject of English at the +2 examination and in cases where passing in English is not necessary according to the regulations of certain Boards/Bodies/Councils/Universities in India, the admission of the candidate shall be provisional and will be confirmed only after he/she has cleared the subject of English as a deficient subject from the parent Board/Body/Council/University in two consecutive chances subsequent to his/her admission. In case a candidate does not clear the relevant subject at any of the two consecutive chances allowed to him/her subsequent to the date of his/her admission, his/her provisional admission to the course shall stand cancelled.

Provided further that :

A candidate who has been placed under compartment in the +2 examination conducted by a Board/Bodies/Councils/University in India shall be eligible to seek admission to the First Semester of B.Com course, provided he/she fulfills the following conditions:

- He/she should have been placed compartment in one subject only;
- He/she should have obtained at least 20% marks in the subject in which he/she had been placed in compartment; and
- He/she should have obtained the requisite percentage of marks in the aggregate of the examination as laid down in the relevant regulations.

The admission of the candidate with a compartment as indicated above shall be provisional and will be confirmed only after he/she has cleared the compartment in two consecutive chances subsequent to his/her admission. In case the candidate does not clear the compartment at any of the two consecutive chances allowed to him/her subsequent to the date of his/her admission, his/her provisional admission to the course shall stand cancelled.

(B) Subject to the reservation made by the University, the admission shall be on merit. The merit for this purpose shall be determined on the basis of the score of a candidate to be computed as follows :

- Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination;
- Add score of 4 for each of the subject passed from the subjects referred in 3.1 A (a) not exceeding 16 in total.

**Explanation :** In case of a compartment candidate, eligibility shall be determined by including the marks of the subject in which the candidate has been placed under compartment.

**Note :** - The candidates securing less than 20% marks in the subject of compartment at the +2 examination be made eligible to join B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Part-I courses, if they cleared or secure 20% or more marks in the subject in the Supplementary Examination held in July/August, on or before the last date for admission with late fee with the permission of the Vice-Chancellor, provided the seat/s is/are available (Syndicate para 43 (xiv) meeting held on 27-01-2013).

#### ADMISSION FOR B.Sc. Agriculture (4-Year Course) (Semester System):-

Eligibility for admission to first semester will be clear pass in XII examination from a recognized Board, with-

- Physics, Chemistry, Maths/Computers or (Non-Medical Stream)
- Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology/Agriculture (Medical Stream)
- XII in Agriculture Stream

The candidate with Physics, Chemistry, Maths/Computers will have to clear Botany and Zoology in First and Second semester. Candidate with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology/Agriculture will have to clear Mathematics-I and Mathematics-II in first and second semesters. Candidate having both the options i.e.

Maths and Biology at XII level will have to appear in Botany and Zoology if he/she has been admitted on Non-Medical seat and will have to appear in Maths-I and II if he/she has been admitted on Medical seat.

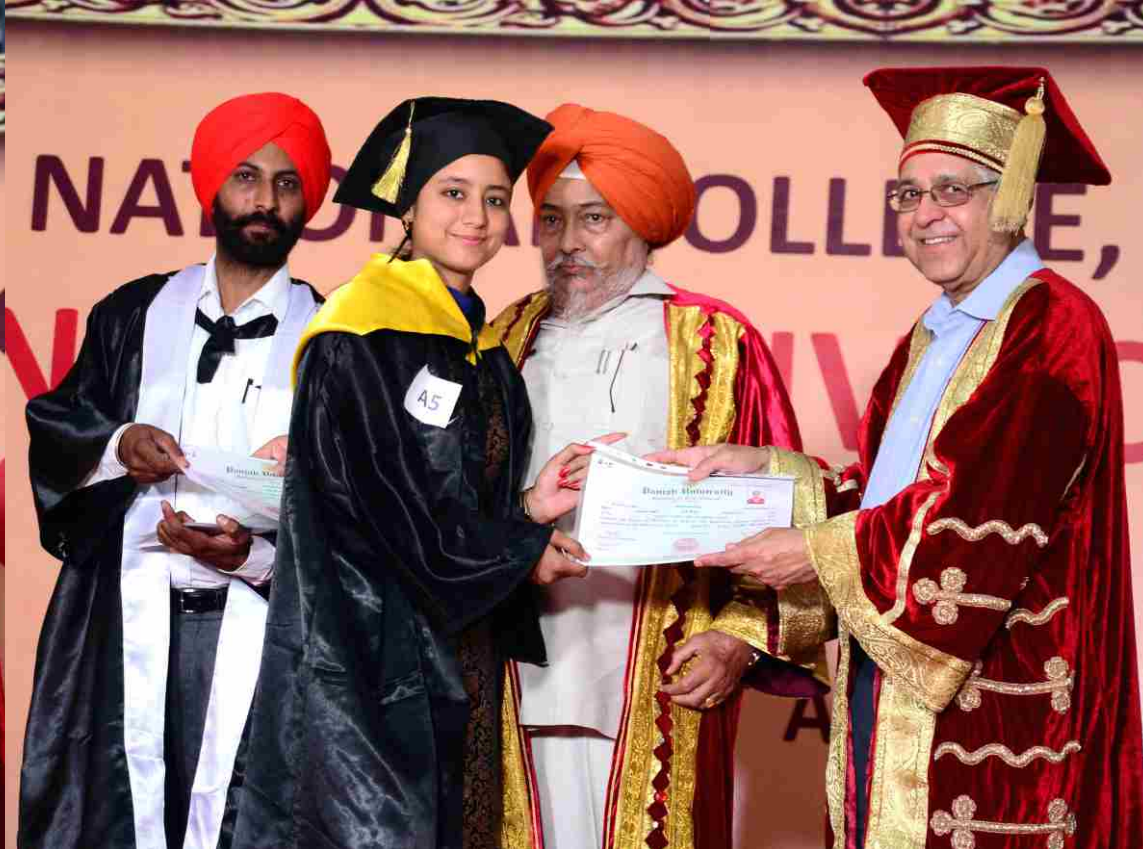

#### Eligibility Conditions for D.P.Ed. (Two years) Course







As per notification of Govt. of Punjab, Department of School Education Admission in D.P.Ed. course will be as follow:

1. Senior Secondary School (+2) or its equivalent examination passed with at least 50% marks. However, 5% relaxation be given to those who have participated in the International/National/S.G.N. Sports Competition. The relaxation in the percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Govt./ State Govt., whichever is applicable.
2. Admission shall be made on merit as per the policy of the State Government.
3. The seats in the private D.P.Ed. institutes duly recognized by NCTE and affiliated with SCERT, Punjab shall be divided in the ratio 60:40. Whereas 40% seats shall be in the management quota for which the institutes shall be free to admit students through an appropriate transparent and fair system duly approved by the SCERT Punjab in advance.
4. For the rest of 60% seats, the admission shall be made through Centralized Counseling/Common Entrance Test and Physical Efficiency Test (Canadian Fitness Test) to be conducted every year by SCERT, Punjab or any other selection process as per the policy of the State Government. The reservation policy as notified by the department of welfare shall be applicable.
5. If above mentioned 60% of seats are not being filled up by SCERT Punjab through Common Entrance Test or otherwise, private D.P.Ed. institutes will be allowed to fill up vacant seats through their own above mentioned system.
6. Date of Centralized Counselling/Common Entrance Test and Physical Efficiency Test (Canadian Fitness

Test) will be announced by SCERT, Punjab every year.

#### Eligibility Conditions for B.P.Ed. - Two years Course (semester system)

As per notification of Govt. of Punjab Department of Higher Education admission will be done as follow:

1. Eligibility of B.P.Ed. (two year course) shall be as below:
  - a) Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 50% marks and having at least participation in the inter College/Inter-Zonal/District/School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.  
Or
  - b) Bachelor's degree in physical education with 45% marks  
Or
  - c) Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 45% marks and studied physical education as compulsory elective subject.  
Or
  - d) Bachelor's degree with 45% marks and having participated in National/Inter University/State competition or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd in position in Inter College/Inter-Zonal/District/School competition in sports and games recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.  
Or
  - e) Bachelor's degree with participation in International competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in National/Inter-University Competition sports and games as recognized by respective federations AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.  
Or
  - f) Graduation with 45% marks and at least three years of teaching experience (for deputed in service candidates i.e. trained physical education teachers/coaches)

The relaxation in the percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Government/State Government whichever is applicable.

2. Applicants who have appeared for the qualifying examination and whose result has not been declared may be provisionally allowed to appear in the physical fitness test at their own risk and responsibility but they have to satisfy the conditions of NCTE Regulation 2014 (Appendix 7) one day prior to display of





merit list.

3. A candidate has to clear Physical Fitness Test to become eligible for admission. Physical Fitness Test will be conducted by the Principal, Prof. Gursewak Singh Government College of Physical Education, Patiala.
4. While calculating merit, credit of 1% of maximum marks will be given to candidates seeking admissions under 85% category, who have passed their 10th and 12th class examination from schools situated in rural areas of Punjab. For this, they will have to submit a certificate issued by the Head/Principal of the school stating that the student has passed 10th and 12th class from his school and that the school falls in the rural area. The certificate should be counter signed by the Sarpanch of the village.
5. For Sports Weightage, only graded certificate by the sports department will be entertained. States where sports gradation procedure is not adopted, the candidate has to bring the certificate issued by Director Sports of their respective states clearly indicating that the candidate's certificate are original and he/she has actually participated in the competition and sports gradation procedure is not adopted in their states.
6. The merit of each candidate who has qualified the physical fitness test shall be determined as follows:-  
**For admission in B.P.Ed. (Two Year Course)**
  - (i) Weightage to Academics 50%  
(40% for basic academics  
5% higher additional qualifications/NIS Diploma (1 year)  
5% for Co-curricular activities)
  - (ii) Weightage to Sports achievements 50%  
(As per Guidelines issued vide letter No. 47/26/83-1 SS/2036 Dated 10.12.97, letter no. 47/26/97-1SS/1496 Dated 21.7.2000, letter No. 47/26/83-1SS/1103. Dated 5.6.03 letter No. 47/26/93-1SS/1334, Dated 3.7.03. Letter No. 47/26/93-1SS/1431, Dated 14.7.03 by Department of Sports and Youth Services, Punjab)
8. Reservation of Seats shall be as per the policy of the Government of Punjab applicable at the time of admission.
9. **Management Quota Seats:** 15% of the seats out of 85% state quota seats in un-aided private self-financing institutions shall be treated as management quota seats and shall be brought out of the purview of centralized counseling to be conducted by the Counseling College.

#### Eligibility Conditions for M.P.Ed. (Two years) Course

A person who possesses one of the following qualifications shall be eligible to join the course:-

- (a) Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed.) or equivalent with at least 50% marks.  
OR

Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) in Health and Physical Education with at least 50% marks.

- (b) The reservation in seats and relaxation in the qualifying marks for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Government/State Government, whichever is applicable.

## RULES FOR ADMISSION

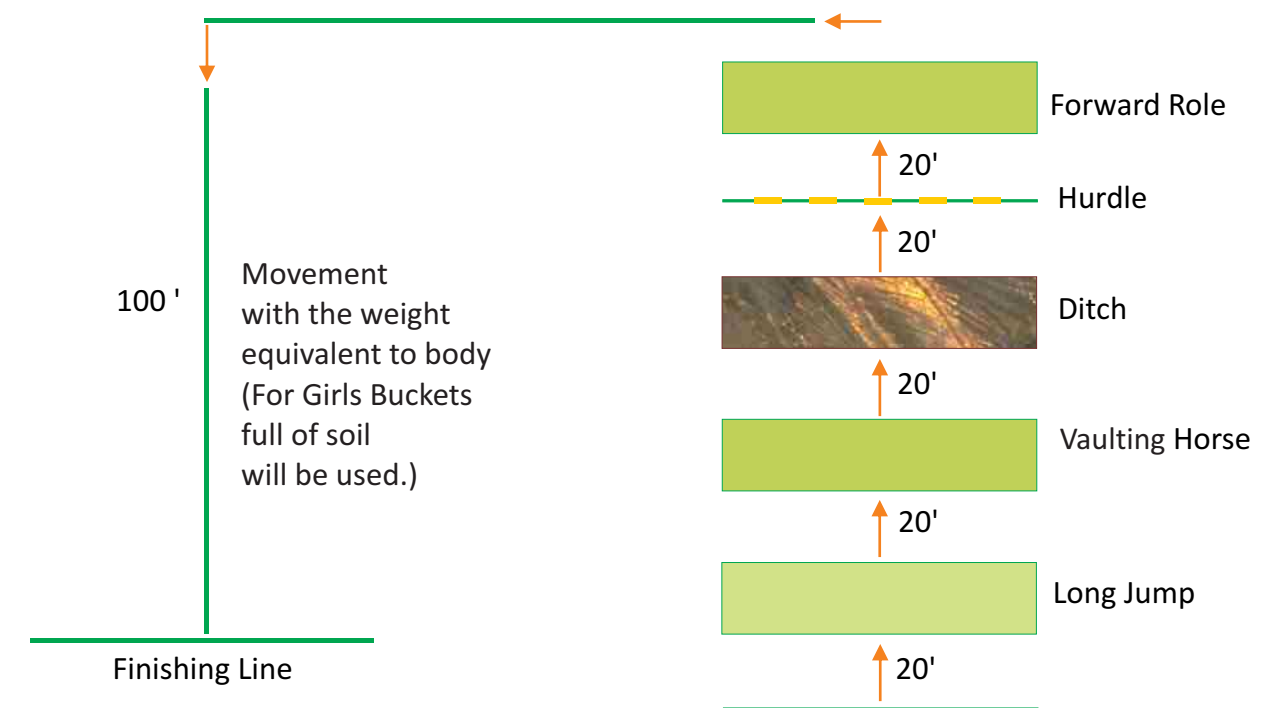
1. Candidate must agree to terms and Conditions of Pb. Govt./P.U.Chd/ NCTE/P.S.E.B. implemented from time to time.
2. Every Candidate must appear in Physical Fitness test for admission.  
Failed candidate cannot appear in other tests and interview. In case of foul only one more chance will be given. Long Jump, Vaulting horse, ditch, hurdle, Forward Roll and lifting of weight (as per rules) must be cleared in prescribed time.
3. At the time of interview the gradation of certificates is must. All those games whose gradation is not done by sports department of Punjab but recognized and graded by All India Inter University or National School Games federation will be entertained.

**Note:-** No Gradation is needed for a certificate issued by P.U.Chd. The Following Conditions Must be Fulfilled to take advantage of non- Graded Certificates.

(a) All Those Games whose Gradation is not done by Sports Department, Punjab.

(b) It is Necessary to bring proof incase of All India Inter University Level Competitions From Sports Director of University, from President/Secretary of Association in case of National Level Competition,

President/ Secretary of Association of District in case of state Level Competition and from Principal of Institution While Considering Inter College Competitions.

4. It is Necessary to Present all the document/graded Certificates during Interview, no document would be considered later.

5. Candidates clearing efficiency test are required to present the original certificates regarding qualifications and claiming for reservation at the time of interview.

6. Selected candidate would have to submit medical fitness certificate issued by Registered medical practitioner. Candidate found unfit during course will not be allowed to continue his/her studies.

7. Two Marks per year and maximum ten marks would be given to candidate working as physical education teacher/Coach in any recognized institution only if his/her experience certificate is attested by D.E.O/C.E.O.

8. Candidate appearing for admission must be in the age of 17 to 40 years. In service candidates who are working as physical education teacher are exempted from efficiency test.

9. Admission of candidate would be cancelled immediately if any detail regarding certificates is found wrong and a legal action will be taken.

10. Selected candidates have to submit following documents :-

- (a) Basic qualification certificate.
- (b) Character Certificate issued by head of previous Institution/ certificate issued by Gazetted officer in case of private candidate
- (c) Candidature Certificate
- (d) Medical Fitness Certificate
- (e) N.O.C. and leave certificate from employer for in service teacher/ coach
- (f) Undertaking Certificate from parents/guardian

11. Attested Photocopies of required certificates have to be attached with admission form. Only those original certificates would be considered the copies of which have been attached.

12. (a) Migration Certificate if previous examination is passed from any other university/Board other than Panjab University.

(b) Equivalency certificate (if required)

13. Decision of Committee evaluating the original sports certificates would be final and binding.

14. List of Candidates selected for admission will be put on notice board. Timely depositing the fee will be sole responsibility of Candidate himself/herself, next preference would be given to candidates appearing on waiting list, no separate information would be sent to them.

15. In case of any dispute regarding the interpretation of rules given in the college prospectus, the decision of principal will be final.

16. Principal & College council using their discretionary power can refuse admission to any candidate.

17. If any candidate leaves college after taking admission he/she will have to deposit fee for next 3 months.

18. The students having one year or more gap after +2 must submit affidavit.

#### Hostel Rules

1. An Application must be written for the admission to the hostel and is to be submitted to the office at

the time of admission.

2. Hostel is compulsory for students of D.P.Ed., B.P.Ed. & M.P.Ed. classes except those students having residence in Jodhan, Narangwal, Lohgarh, Mahima Singh Wala, Misra Singh Wala, Aasi Kalan, Kila Raipur, Gujjarwal, Ballawal, Jartoli, Ghunghrana and Pakhowal.

3. The hostel fee have to be paid at the time of admission along with college fee. And the Expenditures of mess has to be paid till 5<sup>th</sup> day of every month. After that 50 Rs/- per day will be charged as fine.

4. No student will be allowed to take his/her meals out of mess or from anywhere else.

5. It is compulsory to be in the mess at the specified time for the meals. The students shall appear for their meals only in proper dress.

6. No food will be served in the rooms.

7. The students are responsible for the cleanliness of their own rooms.

8. In case of any damage to the property of the hostel, the students has to compensate it.

9. Mobile phones are not allowed in the hostel.

10. Electrical appliances like heater and iron are not allowed in the hostel.

11. Students must switch off the fans, lights etc while leaving the room.

12. On disobeying the rules student will have to be fined.

13. Day-Scholars are not allowed in the rooms of the hostel.

14. Visitors are not allowed/permitted to go into the rooms of the hostel.

15. Permission will not be given to the hostellers to see a movie of their own.

16. For shopping, a local guardian or hostel attendant must accompany them.

17. Evening roll call is compulsory.

18. Students should bring their own bedding and other necessary items.

19. Students are not allowed to bring any valuables. College will not be responsible for any loss.

20. Students can be expelled due to misbehavior or bad character.

21. Parents, Principal and Hostel warden meet on the very first day of joining the hostel. Every Student has to submit the Photographs of any two persons (Only Blood Relation) to whom she/he can meet in the hostel but only with the permission of her/his parents.

22. Principal and warden can inspect the hostel and rooms anytime.

23. Any type of Drugs or illegal things are not allowed in the hostel.

24. Smoking/ playing cards/ drinking alcohol) and use of any other intoxicants is not permitted in the hostel.

25. Quarrels and disputes are to be avoided.

26. During illness, the students have to send their application on the same day recommended by the warden and then duty signed by their tutor.

27. It is must for the students of D.P.E.D, B.P.E.D and M.P.E.D to Join at the hostel.

28. A Student leaving the Hostel for more than ten day without permission will not be allowed to stay in the Hostel.

29. Hostel Fee is non- refundable.

29. All the Students of the Hostel Will Message obey the rules given in the prospectus.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**Change of Subject:** - A Student is permitted to change his/her subject within 15 days only with the permission of principal. No Student will be allowed to change the Subject after this. The students must write a subject- change application duly signed by the concerned teachers and parents. Admission to a course/Subject will be given, provided there is availability of seat and in compliance with the subject combination offered by college as per university rules.

#### **Rules Regarding Admission**

1. Application for admission is to be submitted only on the PRESCRIBED FORM attached with this prospectus.
2. The students must bring their ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS at the time of admission.
3. The candidate must be Present Personally at the time of admission.
4. The admission form must be signed by the parents or guardians.
5. Incomplete application Form will not be considered.
6. BLOOD GROUP CERTIFICATE (issued by a competent and recognized laboratory) should be attached with the form.
7. PROOF OF GAP in studies (if any) must be submitted at the time of admission.
8. The students who take part in EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES are given preference for admission.
9. It is mandatory for a student seeking admission in different streams such as humanities, science or M.A in different subjects to fill up Different Forms No change from one group another shall be allowed later on.
10. Preference is given to children of Defense Personnel who are in service.
11. Those students who has been Disqualified by any Board/University will not be granted admission to



the college.

12. Those students whose results are late can take admission within 10 days of the declaration of their results.
13. A Student with compartment in any subject in the previous examination will be given PROVISIONAL admission to the next class.
14. The Principal reserves the right to cancel the application form of any student without assigning any reason.
15. Subjects/ Stream taken up in the first year cannot be changed in the second year or the third year.
16. A Student of any other university who is placed in Compartment in 1<sup>st</sup> year/ 2<sup>nd</sup> year of B.A/B.Sc/ B.C.A/ M.A Course will not be allowed to join the 2<sup>nd</sup> year/ 3<sup>rd</sup> year course of this university.

#### **CERTIFICATES TO BE ATTACHED**

Attested Photocopies of the following documents/certificates should be attached with the application form:-

1. Certificate showing date of birth.
2. Marks cards of passed classes.
3. Four passport size recent photographs.
4. The character certificate and No-objection certificate issued by the principal of the last institute attended or by a gazetted officer.
5. Photocopy of Roll No. cum registration (PUPIN card) card or any other identity card.
6. Migration certificate if migrating from any other university/ Board other than Panjab University/ Punjab School Education Board.
7. Students from Foreign University will be granted admission only after they submit the Eligibility certificate obtained from Panjab University.
8. Certificates of Extra- curricular Activities.
9. Caste Certificate and income certificate by candidates from backward classes and Scheduled castes.



10. Blood Group certificate issued by a competent laboratory.
11. A Separate form is required to be filled for availing the hostel facility.

#### General Admission Rules

1. Admission to the college is done without any religious, caste or racial discrimination.
2. All admissions are provisional and subject to the approval of Panjab University, Chandigarh. The college will not be responsible, if at any stage, a candidate is declared ineligible for admission to any particular class. Claims for refund of fee on this account will not be entertained. The candidates are, therefore, advised in their own interest to confirm eligibility from the university and, not to make wrong or incomplete statement/declaration, neither hide some necessary facts not attach false or incomplete documents.
3. Students with practical subjects Arts/ Non-Medical will pay extra fee as per university rules.
4. Fees once paid will not be refunded.
5. At the time of admission students have to pay 6 months fees + other funds.
6. Migration is not allowed without any legitimate reason.
7. Admission on the basis of wrong information and false certificates shall be cancelled.
8. In case of cancellation of admission no funds or fee will be refunded.

**Special Note:-** The rules and regulations of Panjab University Chandigarh and directions of Panjab Govt. Shall have an overriding effect over the rules of the college. In case any dispute arises regarding the interpretation of the rules given in the college prospectus, the decision of the principal will be final.

#### ATTENDANCE:-

- In order to be eligible to appear in the final examination of university, it is compulsory for each student to attend at least 75% lectures in each subject (Theory and practical separately) If a student remains



absent for 15 days continuously without prior information to the college, his/her name will be struck off from the college and the student will have to seek re-admission with the permission of the principal.

- The condonation of shortage of lectures cannot be claimed as a matter of right. However the principal may condone a shortage of lectures/ tutorials/ practical's delivered for valid reasons as per university rules.
- The concession will be only for those students who fulfill the conditions of minimum marks in the house examinations.

#### LEAVE RULES

- It is Compulsory to write an application for leave.
- The leave application has to be signed by the parent/guardian and it is compulsory to get the leave sanctioned in advance.
- Leave for 5 to 10 days can be sanctioned by the tutor or the senior tutor and the principal.
- In case of medical leave, a Medical certificate signed by MBBS/MD Doctor Must be attached with the leave form.
- Submission of leave/Medical leave allows exemption from fine only and it does not exempt the student from other conditions which are required to be fulfilled for appearing in the final examination.
- Student who remains absent for the whole day will be fined rupees ten per day otherwise rupees five per period.

#### IDENTITY CARD CUM LIBRARY CARD

It is compulsory for each student to get an identity cum library card issued by the librarian in the beginning of the session. The student must carry their card with them during the college hours failing which they will be fined. In case the card is lost, it may be re-issued on the payment of rupees fifty.

### MOBILE PHONES NOT ALLOWED

The Students are not allowed to carry Mobile Phones in the college campus during teaching days or during examinations.

### HOUSE EXAMINATION

In accordance with university rules, House Examination will be conducted in September and December for annual classes. It is compulsory for a student to appear in both the House examinations and secure at least 25% Marks in aggregate in the Examinations. A student who does not appear in both the examination or does not fulfill the necessary conditions will be detained. For Semester classes there will be only one house examination before each semester and rest of the conditions are same as for annual classes.

- Internal Assessment of each student will be sent to the university on the basis of the marks secured in House examinations and other co-curricular activities.
- In case of illness during the house examination, medical leave has to be submitted.
- Student using unfair means will be fined rupees one thousand and his/her admission may be cancelled.
- If any candidate fails to fulfill the conditions a sum of rupees three thousand will be charged for re-examination.

### INFRASTRUCTURE AND OTHER FACILITIES

#### Library

The College has a well-stocked library consisting of more than twenty four thousand books with INFLIBNET facility. For making the best use of the library, the following rules are to be adhered to:-

1. Books from the library will be issued only for 14 days, after that a fine of Rupee 1 per book per day will be charged.
2. Each U.G. student can be issued 4 books and P.G Student 6 books at a time.



3. If a student loses, defaces or mutilates a book, he/she has to replace the book or pay double the cost of that book. If a book is rare and is not easily available, he/she will have to pay the price fixed by the principal.
4. An issued book may be recalled at any time at the discretion of the librarian.
5. While using the library, the students are required to maintain complete silence and discipline.
6. A Student can draw a prescribed text book in the subjects of Punjabi, Hindi and English on depositing his/her identity card However the book has to be returned on the same day.
7. Students can get Photostat copies of important articles on nominal charges.
8. Magazine, Journals etc. cannot be issued. Student can read these in library only.

#### BOOK BANK

The needy and meritorious students are issued books from the book bank for the entire academic session on the recommendation of the tutor and with the permission of the principal.

#### MAGAZINE SECTION

Various magazines and newspapers pertaining to different languages are available in this section. Old editions of magazines can be issued to the students for one day only.

#### HOSTEL

Excellent hostel facilities exist both for boys and girls separately. The hostel rules are to be followed strictly. For detailed information, contact the hostel Wardens.

#### COMPUTER FACILITY

The department of Computer Science and application provides computer facilities to all the students and faculty members. The department is equipped with latest infrastructure. There are four high tech computer labs equipped with systems of latest configurations, Scanners, Smart board, Projectors etc. Almost all Computers are equipped with access to internet.





### PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORTS FACILITIES

The college has well-maintained extensive playgrounds for Volleyball, Handball, Hockey, Lawn Tennis, Table Tennis, Badminton, basketball and athletics. There is also the facilities of shooting range and sports auditorium and Gymnasium in the college campus.

### COLLEGE CANTEEN

The college has a well furnished canteen which provides a variety of clean and hygienic eatables at reasonable price.

### College Magazine- GOVIND DARPAN

For providing opportunities to students to express themselves and to develop their talent of writing. College publishes Magazine 'GOVIND DARPAN' annually containing English, Punjabi, Hindi, Science and activities sections along with planning Forum. The principal nominates staff Editors every year where as the students Editors are selected by holding tests for various sections.

### NSS

In order to enthuse the virtue of selfless social service and educate the youth towards constructive service, the college enrolls students in its NSS units every year. The unit organizes a seven days and one day camps every year. A unit of 100 volunteers has been sanctioned through the university by the ministry of Education and Social welfare.

### STUDENTS FEED BACK

There is a provision to get feedback from the students about the functioning of the college. The outgoing classes fill up a feedback Performa and it is kept confidential.

### TUTORIAL GROUPS

All the students are divided into a number of groups. Tutorials are held on every 2<sup>nd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday of the month. It is compulsory for the students to attend tutorials. During the tutorials students interact freely with their tutors. The students are given information about general discipline in the college, functioning of the college, importance of various subjects, job prospects, college activities, scholarships etc. Besides this students get a chance to discuss their suggestion and problems with their teachers.

### YOUTH CLUB

The members of this club aim to work for the society and for youth welfare and participate in



various cultural activities.

### ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

The college has a vibrant alumni association with numerous registered members. It has an active body of executive members. The association regularly participates in various college activities besides helping the institute and the present/old students in every possible way. Through cultural events the alumni members are regularly in touch with their alma mater. Eminent alumni members are also honoured.

- The meeting of Alumni is held every year on 26<sup>th</sup> January.

### SPORTS AND OTHER CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The College holds annual athletic meet every year. Prizes are awarded to the winners. There are well maintained playgrounds. A well equipped gym, Shooting Range and Indoor Sports Auditorium. In addition to academic and physical activities the college provides facilities for other co-curricular activities. Educational tours are also arranged for the students every year. Guru Gobind SINGH Study circle is also established for the students to inculcate religious, moral and ethical values in them.

-There are also the facilities of telephone service, fax, Photostat, internet, inverters, Generator set and bus service for the students.

- In the Annual Prize Distribution and convocation of the college, prizes, merit certificates, degrees and special prizes to distinguish students are awarded.

6. Students caught bunking classes and sitting in the canteen/loitering in corridors shall be fined on the spot.

9. Students Should take care of college property. Anyone found guilty of littering about or writing anything objectionable on walls/furniture shall be fined heavily.

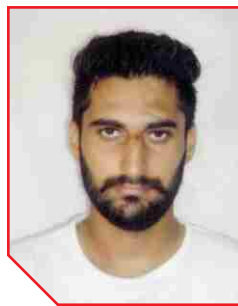
