

# GENERAL ACADEMIC ORDINANCES & REGULATIONS

## 1. ADMISSION AND ELIGIBILITY FRAMEWORKS

- 1.1. Admission to all undergraduate (B.A., B.Sc., B.Com., B.Voc., BPE) and postgraduate (M.A., M.Sc.) programs shall be strictly governed by the eligibility criteria, combinations, and cut-off rules specified by Panjab University, Chandigarh.
- 1.2. No student shall be admitted provisionally if they fail to produce the mandatory migrating or lower-examination qualifying certificates at the time of counseling.

## 2. CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS) & COURSE WORK

- 2.1. The college follows the continuous evaluation and credit assignment model dictated by the parent university frameworks.
- 2.2. Students must opt for designated subject elective combinations during entry into the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) program. Shifting of chosen streams or electives is strictly forbidden after the standard university registration deadline.

## 3. MANDATORY ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1. Every student is required to attend a minimum of 75% of the total lectures delivered in each individual subject/paper, including practical laboratory slots.
- 3.2. Condolence or relaxation of shortage up to a maximum limit authorized by the Panjab University Calendar can only be sanctioned by the Principal upon production of verified medical certificates or official sports participation bills within 7 days of the absence.
- 3.3. Students falling short of the mandatory 75% baseline will be strictly barred from appearing in the End-Semester University Examinations.
