

STATUTORY COMPLIANCE DIRECTIVES FOR NCTE-RECOGNIZED COURSES

[Governed by NCTE Regulations and Panjab University Ordinances]

1. RECOGNITION AND PROGRAM SCOPE

- 1.1. This framework applies strictly to the professional teacher-training and sports science programs conducted by the institution:
 - a. Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed. - 2 Years)
 - b. Master of Physical Education (M.P.Ed. - 2 Years)
 - c. Diploma in Physical Education (D.P.Ed. - 2 Years)
- 1.2. All structural operations, staff appointments, and infrastructural upkeep must obey the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) norms.

2. ATTENDANCE & PRACTICAL STANDARDS

- 2.1. In accordance with strict NCTE mandates, students enrolled in professional B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. programs must maintain a minimum of 80% attendance in all theory modules and 90% attendance in all field-based practical/training slots.
- 2.2. No relaxation down to standard arts/science guidelines (75%) will be permitted for NCTE professional tracks.

3. STAFF MATRIX & INFRASTRUCTURE INTEGRITY

- 3.1. The department shall maintain a clean faculty-to-student ratio matching NCTE benchmarks. All appointments must undergo the statutory Panjab University selection panel procedures.
- 3.2. The structural maintenance of track fields, indoor sports centers, equipment labs, and physiological libraries will be audited annually by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) to certify total compliance before submitting the Annual Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) to the NCTE portal.
